

in the left-hand sidebar; this will take you to your Video Library. Now click the “+Live” button at the top-right corner of the screen.

- Step 2: Once you’ve clicked “+Live,” a new window will open. This window contains important data that’s dynamically created (in other words, it will be different each time you open it). You’ll need to copy/paste some of it into your streaming software application.

If your software supports Single Field streams, simply paste the data in the top field (Server or Stream URL) into your Settings area; if it supports Separate Fields, paste both

the Server URL and the Stream Key data.

- Step 3: Activate your streaming software and click “Preview.” If everything is working correctly, you’ll see a preview of your live stream within the Preview window. If not, you’ll need to check your settings and try again. Obviously, you don’t want to be doing any of this a few minutes prior to your planned stream, so give your team ample time to get everything working smoothly. ■
